Consideration of NOC Online applications

Case no. 343

(Shri Vishesh Kumar Tiwari, C-31, G. Floor, Khidki Extn., New Delhi-110017)

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+Stilt+GF+3 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 18 mtrs (including mumty parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at 163, Kailash Hills, New Delhi; with floor area of Stilt=GF=FF=SF=TF= 156.96 sqm and Basement= 156.96 sqm with depth= 3.20 mtrs. The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of CA, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building.

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+Stilt+GF+3 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 18 mtrs (including mumty parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at A-2, Soami Nagar, New Delhi; with floor area of Stilt=GF=513.43 sqm, FF=SF=TF=484.57 sqm and basement= 492.97 with depth= 4.0mtrs. The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of CA, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building.

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Basement+Stilt+GF+2 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 17.90 mtrs (including mumty parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at Block no. 25/128-129, Shakti Nagar, Delhi; with floor area of Stilt=GF=FF=SF=187.49 sqm and basement= 186.47 with depth= 3.65 mtrs. The NOC is recommended to be granted with the terms and conditions mentioned in report of CA, Delhi. The applicant should follow the local building bye-laws while constructing the building.

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for additional construction of TF over existing Basement+Stilt+GF+2 floors with the total height of the building restricted to 15.7 mtrs (including mumty parapet, water-storage, lift machine room etc.) at Plot no. B-5, Situated at Nizamuddin West, New Delhi; with proposed floor area of TF = 84.360 sqm; subject to the condition that the applicant should submit the section plan indicating the total height of the building (in metric system) to NMA.
