Consideration of NOC applications

Online Case

Maharashtra Case no. 12

(Shama Vikramraj Chauhan, Plot No 610, Aditya Bunglow, Kher Section, Ambernath (East) 421501 Thane Maharashtra)

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **Send back/Return** the case and ask the applicant to submit the revised plan with the total height restricted to 11.00 mtr (inclusive all) as the Authority has taken a policy decision that no construction should be allowed above 11.00 meter near the Centrally Protected Monuments "Shiv Mandir", Ambernath, Thane, Maharashtra.

Punjab Case no. 36

(Gurdeep Singh S/o Mahinder Singh, House No. 6673, Purana Thana, Mohlla Bhuleria Wala, Bathinda, Punjab)

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of GF staircase and proposed FF on the existing GF with the total height of 8.07mtrs (including mumty, parapet, water storage tank etc.) at MCB Z1-05270, Bathinda, Bathinda, Punjab; with proposed floor area of FF= 3.71sqm.



After perusal of the application and revised building plan received from CA, Tamilnadu, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of Stilt+3 floor with headroom and water tank with the total height of 14.44 mtr (including mumty, parapet, water storage tank etc.) at Plot No. 12, Indian Colony, Survey No. 279/6, 7 & 13 as per TSLR Patta T.S. No. 111/2, Block- 3, Ward- H, Keelkattalai Village, Pallavaram Taluk, Pallavaram Municipality Limit, Chengalpattu District; with floor area of Stilt= 105.29 sqm, FF=SF=TF=107.62 sqm and Stair Case= 52.00 sqm.

After perusal of the application and information received from CA, Rajasthan, it was decided to **Reject** the case as the proposed construction falls within the prohibited area of the Centrally Protected Monuments. No construction temporary or permanent is permissible in Prohibited area of the Centrally Protected Monument as per Section 20A (4) of AMASR Act 1958.

After perusal of the application, it was decided that the Authority will **visit** the proposed site of construction with local officials of Archeological Survey of India and Competent Authority, West Bengal before making any final recommendation.

(District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas, on Behalf of the owner Government Land (Khatian No.-1 in the name of Collector on Behalf of the Government of West Bengal), Office of the District Magistrate, North 24 parganas Barasat, Kolkata-700 124.)

After perusal of the application information received from CA, West Bengal, it was decided to **Reject** the case as the applicant had already completed the construction work without taking prior approval from the Authority in violation of section 20C (2)

of AMASR Act. 1958. It was also decided to ask clarification from Competent Authority regarding the already constructed building.

No. 8483/1A/2+8483/1A/3+8483/3 Near Navives Police Chowky, Murarji Peth, Dist-Solapur-431007; with floor area of GF/Stilt=205.88 sqm and FF=SF=TF=FF=206.86 sqm.

After perusal of the application, it was decided to **Send back/Return** the case and ask the applicant to submit the revised plan with the total height restricted to 18.00 mtr (inclusive all) as the maximum height given by Authority near the monument is 18.00 mtr (inclusive all).



After perusal of the application, it was decided to **recommend** grant of NOC in this case for construction of GF+2+Head room with the total height of 12.05 mtrs (including mumty, parapet, water storage tank etc.) at Sy. No. 884/3-2, Methala Village, Kodungallur Taluk; with Built-up area of GF= FF=143.73 sqm, SF=192.45 sqm and Head room & Machine room= 18.57 sqm. The construction work should incorporate Mangalore Tiled Sloping Roof and colour scheme of the monument should be kept in view while constructing the building.

The construction work should incorporate Mangalore Tiled Sloping Roof and colour scheme of the monument should be kept in view while constructing the building.

The issue of the Categorisation of monuments/sites was also discussed in the meeting MS, NMA informed that the categorization of 918 monuments in respect of six circles (Bhopal, Chandigarh, Delhi, Jabalpur, Kolkata and Vadodara) has been completed and will be submitted shortly in the Ministry of Culture. Member Secretary further informed that draft categorisation in respect of the monuments/sites in respect of 870 monuments have also been completed in respect of the following

circles (Mumbai, Sarnath, Patna, Shimla, Lucknow Jaipur, Thrissur, Nagpur, Srinagar and Raipur). Sample of Some of the categorization of monuments have also been shown to the Members. It was agreed in the meeting that the draft Categorisation will be further verified to avoid any complication and thereafter, will be submitted to Ministry of Culture after following the procedure requirements laid down in the NMA Rules, 2011.
